- **24.** Tomorrow, Christy Harrison and Peter Sensenig, and their family, are scheduled to fly home to Chad. Pray for wisdom and God's leading, as Chad is refusing to issue new visas to U.S. citizens, in response to the United States's ban on issuing visas to Chadian nationals. The family's current visas expire Sept. 23. (p. 10)
- **25.** Today, Mennonite Voluntary Service (MVS) and Service Adventure (SA) participants begin their week-long orientations at their service locations. Pray that the incoming members of the MVS units in San Francisco, California, and Tucson, Arizona; and the SA units in Anchorage, Alaska, and Colorado Springs, Colorado, will have the energy and openness to get a positive start on their year of living in community. (p. 37-39)
- **26.** LCC International University is a liberal arts institution in Lithuania, where students from many nations live together in Christian community. Pray for faculty, staff and students as they transition from summer programs to preparing for the academic year. (p. 27)
- **27.** Pray that Mennonite Christian Hospital's commitment to serving marginalized people in remote communities in Taiwan will continue to offer well-being to all people. (p. 21)

- **30.** A family has been serving in a sensitive ministryin France for 10 years. Pray for them as they assure regional leadership and engage in church planting. (p. 24)
- **31.** Pray for Akiko Aratani and Ray Epp, in Japan, as they teach in a regenerative agriculture education program and manage a spiritual retreat center. (p. 15)

- **2.** Pamela Obonde has joined the administrative team of Africa Inter-Mennonite Mission (AIMM), as a church and donor relations coordinator. AIMM and Mission Network collaborate closely in ministries on the African continent. Pray for Pamela, who is based in Manitoba, Canada, as she builds bridges across agencies, cultures and nations. (p. 11)
- **3.** Today, the youth group from First Mennonite Church in Hutchinson, Kansas, begins a week-long Christ at the Border Just Peace Pilgrimage. Pray for the participants as they learn about the realities of migration at the Mexico-United States border and the justice that Jesus is calling them to.
