

24. One way that Jonah and Memee Yang serve the people of Southeast Asia is through the Compassionate Care curriculum, which is a co-ed alternative to the Sister Care curriculum. Pray for them as they witness breakthroughs with couples who learn to share in one another's pain and celebrate one another's joys, as well as when they experience resistance from the communities where they present the curriculum (p. 18).

25. Bienenberg Theological Seminary is an Anabaptist-Mennonite theological seminary in Switzerland that focuses on social responsibility, peace and reconciliation. Pray for educators and students as they deepen their knowledge of history, theology and ministry from an Anabaptist lens (p. 27).

26. Martine Audéoud and Gary Wittig live in Ivory Coast with their son, Samuel. Martine works at the University of the Christian Alliance of Abidjan, in addition to working remotely for several other academic institutions, training global Christian leaders. Pray for Martine's work and for Samuel, as he begins the process of obtaining a visa to attend a university in the U.S. this fall (p. 10).

27. The Mennonite Evangelical Theological Center of Asunción (CEMTA), the theology and music departments of the Evangelical University of Paraguay, begins the academic year next week. Pray that this year of studies produces excellent learning and fellowship for the students and faculty alike (p. 34).

28. Anicka Fast trains and mentors historians and archivists in Africa, Asia and Latin America, to help promote a recognition of global Anabaptist history. She and her family currently reside in the Netherlands but are planning to move back to Canada this summer. Pray for heartwarming farewells as they prepare for their move and a smooth transition into their new home, especially for the children and their schooling (p. 23).

- 1.** Pray for the people of Venezuela, and Mennonite Mission Network's partner Network of Mennonite Missions of Venezuela, amid the political instability caused by the forceful removal of Venezuela's president by the U.S. last month. Pray that the new governmental leaders will reflect the will of the Venezuelan people and bring peace to the country (p. 34).
- 2.** Today, Julia and Thomas Meyers begin their four-week SOOP placement at the Maria Skobtsova House (MSH) in Calais, France. Pray for them as they share in the MSH's ministry of hospitality to migrants who are seeking refuge while on their way to England (p. 40).
- 3.** Fiona Tito Wheatland is the new president of the Anabaptist Association of Australia & New Zealand, a partner of Mennonite Mission Network. Pray for Wheatland as she becomes acquainted with her new role (p. 21).
- 4.** After a year of being delayed by Caleb's cancer diagnosis and treatment, Caleb and Stephanie Schrock-Hurst are planning to move to Taiwan early this month. Pray for a smooth transition and language acquisition, as they begin working with Mennonite Christian Hospital in Hualien (p. 17).

5. Later this month, the Service Adventure units from Anchorage, Alaska, and Colorado Springs, Colorado, will meet for their spring gathering. Pray for participants and unit leaders as they plan and look forward to this time of fellowship and rest (p. 39).

6. Give thanks to God with La Prairie Church of Montbéliard (France), as they have recently doubled the size of their local team and have been able to expand current ministries and reintroduce other ministries. Pray for wisdom for how to best utilize this influx of human resources, as well as for increased participation in their programs (p. 26).

7. Northeast Asia Regional Peacebuilding Institute (NARPI), in South Korea, creates spaces for peacemakers from across northeast Asia to gather, network and train together. Pray that they are able to sustain their new full-time staff member and continue to offer peace-building spaces for learning (p. 20).

8. Pray for a family serving in Nepal, as political uncertainty, following an uprising in Kathmandu last fall, continues to plague their community and has left them feeling the need for heightened safety measures.

9. Praise God with Ben and Laurel Woodward-Breckbill for a meaningful and joy-filled holiday season at the Paris (France) Mennonite Center. Pray that their hospitality and educational ministries continue to bring them and their communities meaning and joy throughout the year (pp. 25, 26).

10. The Q'eqchi' Mennonite Church is a network of around 125 Q'eqchi'-speaking churches in northern Guatemala. Pray for the women who lead the rapidly-expanding women's ministry, as they empower and encourage women to study the Bible and theology (p. 33).

11. SADRA Conflict Transformation is a peacebuilding organization in South Africa that offers training in conflict resolution and nonviolence. Pray for the SADRA team as they offer peace-education programs for local high schools, train community mediators and provide church leadership development, among other programs (p. 13).

12. Kate Widmer serves with La Prairie Church of Montbéliard (France), in their community outreach ministries, with special attention to programs for the children and women in the Muslim neighborhood where she lives. In December, she began a new mission term, with an increased budget. Please pray for people who are willing to say yes to financially supporting this ministry (p. 25).

13. Alfonsina Finger and José Oyanguren, serving in the Argentine Chaco, have requested prayers for their college-aged son, Juan, who suffers from depression and is refusing treatment of all kinds. Pray for Juan's healing and for Alfonsina and José, as they navigate how to best support him (p. 30).

14. This Valentine's Day let us love one another as Christ loves the church. Pray that people around the world open their hearts to show love to all, even amid differing worldviews and misunderstandings.

15. Angela (Wenger) and Tomoki Yamanaka are associate co-pastors of the Asahikawa Gospel Church in Hokkaido, Japan. Pray for them as they preach God's word (p. 18).

16. Christliche Dienste is the learning and service program for German Mennonite youth that partners with Mission Network's Mennonite Voluntary Service. Pray for this international exchange that broadens the faith of the German participants and their counterparts from the United States and other countries (p. 26).

17. A couple who has served in India for over a decade combines social services outreach with evangelism and church planting. Pray that by meeting people's physical needs, they are able to convey the message of God's love to those who may not otherwise hear it.

18. Last fall, Christy Harrison, Peter Sensenig and their three children temporarily moved to Montbéliard, France, from Chad, after their Chadian visas were not renewed, due to the political relationship between the U.S. and Chad. Pray for this family as they acclimate to their new home and ministry and as they navigate how to proceed if they are unable to return to Chad in the future (p. 10).

19. Pray for the Council of Indigenous Evangelical Peoples and Organizations in Ecuador (FEINE) as they work to strengthen interculturality in society and encourage members to take on social and ecclesial responsibility (p. 33).

20. Two MVS participants in Tucson, Arizona, are serving with Community Home Repair of Arizona (CHRA). Pray for these participants and CHRA, as they provide emergency home repairs to low-income homeowners, as well as adaptive and safety modifications for people with disabilities (p. 38).

21. Delicia Bravo Aguilar and Peter Wigginton have served in Ecuador since 2015. Pray for them as they serve as coordinators for the Ecuador Partnership, which brings together congregations from Colombia, Ecuador and the United States for mutually transformative ministry (p. 29).

22. Friedenshaus (House of Peace), a ministry in Ludwigshafen, Germany, that accompanies migrants and helps provide language tutoring among other life skills, is celebrating its 10th anniversary this year. Give thanks for this ministry's first decade of service and pray for their continued positive influence on the migrant community (p. 26-27).

23. Joseph and Rachel Givens, and their two sons, serve at the Maria Skobtsova House in Calais, France, where they help provide temporary shelter for women and children migrating from the Middle East and Africa and seeking refuge in England. Pray that the Givens find success in their fundraising efforts, so they can continue this ministry (p. 23).
