

Prayer Vine

25. Christy Harrison and Peter Sensenig, and their three children, are relocating from France to Beirut, Lebanon, in August. Pray for this family, as they prepare to move, yet again, to a new ministry post, saying goodbye to their friends and the place they have called home for the past year (p. 24).

26. Jonah and Memee Yang offer trainings in Southeast Asia, with a focus on discipleship, equipping youth and families, and holistic community building. Pray for Jonah, as he teaches Anabaptist Mennonite Biblical Seminary's Journey Missional Leadership Development program, and for Memee, as she works with women using the Sister Care curriculum (p. 17).

27. Freddy Barrón and Margrit Kipfer Barrón have served with the Bolivia Mennonite Church for more than three decades. Pray for them as Freddy pastors a congregation and Margrit coordinates Christian education ministries. Together, they mentor young church leaders and support church plants (p. 30).

28. Praise God for Comunidad de Instituciones Teológicas Anabautistas (CITA, Community of Anabaptist Theological Institutions), a network of Anabaptist education programs in Latin America that cooperate to make online education and leadership development accessible in Spanish. Pray that Anabaptist leaders throughout the Spanish-speaking world would find and use CITA's resources to expand the Kingdom of God (p. 35).

29. Northeast Asia Regional Peacebuilding Institute (NARPI), in South Korea, creates spaces for peacemakers from across northeast Asia to gather, network and train together. Pray that their peacebuilding spaces continue to provide a place of learning for their community (p. 21).

30. Kate Widmer serves with the La Prairie church of Montbéliard, France, through a variety of ministries. She leads women's groups, girls' groups and sewing classes, as well as helping in the church's café and bookstore, among many other ministries. Pray for energy as she pours herself out in so many directions (p. 25).

31. Praise God for the Mennonite Bible School in South Africa, where training takes place in Indigenous languages and people of many denominations study together (p. 13).

- 7.** Mennonite Voluntary Service participants will end their term this month. Pray for these young adults as they say goodbye to the friends they have spent the past year, or two, making and leave the organizations they have poured their hearts into. Pray that this experience will have lasting effects for the participants the people whose lives they touched during their service term (pp. 40-41).
- 8.** Delicia Bravo Aguilar and Peter Wigginton have spent a considerable time apart over the past few months, due to Delicia spending time with her mother while she was ill and Peter traveling to the United States for a speaking engagement. - 10.** JCS International is a consortium of Christian organizations in Mongolia that share the good news of Jesus. Pray for their many methods of outreach, including supporting counselors, providing safe spaces for children and families to play, and hosting educational programs (p. 20).
- 11.** Ben and Laurel Woodward-Breckbill, and their two children, will be in the United States for the next two months for their North American Ministry. Pray for this family as they spend the rest of July traveling across the country, visiting supporting congregations, friends and family (p. 26).
- 12.** Pray for a mission worker and her family serving in Nepal, as they continue to grieve the sudden passing of her mother. The family is spending a large portion of their summer in Canada for a variety of purposes, including bereavement, celebrating the graduation of their son and pre-planned speaking engagements (p. 16).

- 20.** This week, this year's new Service Adventure leaders will attend orientation in Elkhart, Indiana. Pray for these new unit leaders as they learn about Mission Network, the Service Adventure program and their role as unit leaders. Pray also for guidance as they plan and prepare for the participant orientation that will take place in August (p. 42).
- 21.** Caleb and Stephanie Schrock-Hurst are leading a fellowship time with Filipino nursing aides working at Mennonite Christian Hospital in Hualien, Taiwan. Pray that this gathering will continue to be edifying to the participants and that the Schrock-Hursts will be able to support them through the challenges of being away from home (p. 16).
- 22.** Robin Gingerich has been serving at LCC International University in Lithuania since 2001. Pray for her, as well as the university faculty, staff and students, as they enjoy their summer vacation (p. 23).
